Rules for use of MADOC Property

The following rules apply:

- 1. Close the gate after entering the property.
- 2. If you unlock the bathroom shed you must lock it when you leave. If someone else is still there ask them to lock up. Do not just assume the last person there will "lock up". During the cold time of the year the water must also be turned off when you leave and on when you arrive.
- 3. Treat the agility equipment with care.
- 4. Do not tie your dog to the fence or fence posts.
- 5. Do not allow your dog to run loose on the agility field while you are building the course.
- 6. If you are at the property by yourself you may allow your dog to be "loose" outside the agility field, but if someone else is there your dog can only be loose under your direct control. (No running the fence, etc.)
- 7. The field is not to be used for private lessons. (That is lessons you charge to give)
- 8. If the contacts are moved out of the way against the fence to conduct a class or to mow grass they must be moved back onto the field when you are finished. This is because when someone comes out alone to work their dog they cannot move the contacts by themselves.
- 9. The membership should be notified when a class is being held so no one will come to work their dog and discover they can't.
- 10. Common courtesy should be used by everyone. If a person or group is using the field and someone else arrives to work their dog the field must be shared. Take "turns" and do not make anyone wait too long a time. The field belongs to everyone.
- 11. When you use the field you may move obstacles (with care) to set up what you want to work.
- 12. You must: "pick up" after your dog and take it home with you.
- 13. If you use the field you must sign up to take a turn at mowing.
- 14. A non-club member may use the field during scheduled classes. They may not use the field at any other time (even if accompanied by a club member).
